Latest on CC&R and Bylaws Update

This notice is a follow on to previous notices in Splashers as well as the presentation at the Spring 2024 General Meeting. We are nearing finalization of the updated CC&Rs and By-laws.

Final documents and election materials will be distributed to Members for the Vote – to approve this update. Our current CC&R's require a 70% vote of our 318 homes for approval – so 223 members must vote for approval. This is a very high standard, and anyone who does not vote will count as a no. If we are unable to get an affirmative vote or the necessary quorum, we will be taking the matter to a court proceeding to approve the document update which could potentially trigger a **special assessment at a minimum cost of \$15,000 to the HOA**. Therefore, it is very important that every homeowner vote in the affirmative for this update. We will be having a meeting in the coming months to review the update, provide an opportunity for homeowners to ask questions and discuss the necessary changes so that everyone can be well informed as you cast your vote. We are also asking for volunteers to help us go door to door to get the necessary votes.

This is Lillian's first championship win.

"The Frog Jump is a family legacy that has become a big tradition for all of us every year" Lillian said, "I'm so happy to see my children and grandchildren competing every year, I just hope they're not scared that I might break the world record and win the \$20,000 cash prize next year!"

Dog Walking Etiquette

A Shadow Brook resident sent an email to the ACC requesting that we remind our neighbors about the proper etiquette of dog walking. As a former dog owner, my wife and I enjoyed walking our Buster and meeting many neighbors.

Everyone deserves to have their property respected. Here are a few reminders for people walking their dogs in our neighborhood:

- Always bring plenty of bags on the walk and clean up any mess your dog leaves. Cleaning up after your dog isn't just being a good neighbor, it's also the law. If you have kids that walk your dog, ensure they also understand proper dog walking etiquette.
- **Don't allow your dog to walk on your neighbors' lawns.** People work hard to maintain their lawns and don't deserve to have yellow spots blight their appearance.
- Use a shorter leash to control where your dog is permitted to walk. It is possible to direct where your dog should go with a shorter leash and also staying alert when your dog needs to poop. For example, the parking strip between the sidewalk and street is a better choice than a neighbor's front yard lawn.
- Be mindful when walking your dog and share the sidewalk. Staying off your phone will help ensure you don't encounter an approaching dog who may not be as friendly as your dog.
- Discard your dog's poop bag in your own garbage can; do not place it in your neighbors' cans.
